Families who choose to participate in CR partner with a Family Coach to identify needs which may include, but not limited to:

- Finding resources for basic needs including housing, utilities, food and transportation.
- Parenting skills & managing children's behavior challenges.
- Life skills including job search skills.
- Budgeting and money management.
- Child care and education resources.
- Adult education and GED resources.
- Finding new connections in the community.
- Building a family support system personalized to family needs and individual situations.

Who can we serve?

- Single and two parent families WITH children 18 & younger residing with them
- Parents/caregivers can be legal guardians (or not) to the children
- Proof of Citizenship not required
- Probation cases if determined there is a need beyond what Probation can provide for the individual.
- Pregnant or parenting youth/young adults
- Young adults without children (ages 19-24)

How Can You Join?

- Fill out the attached REFERRAL FORM (or on our website) and give to your school social worker, counselor, home visitor or staff at a community service agency.
- If eligible, you will be contacted by a Central Navigator.
- After reviewing the responsibilities of both you and your Family Coach, he/she will help you decide how to best partner with you to meet your family's needs.
- Your Family Coach will work with a team to assist you and your family in meeting your goals, big or small.
- You and your Coach will communicate through home visits, phone calls, and team meetings all centered toward you and your family.
